Core Values

Lindum Squash Club is a welcoming and inclusive Club.

Core values underpin everything which Lindum Squash Club does and individual members are required to abide by the following core values:

Rules

Furthermore individual members are required to comply with the following rules:

- to act at all times in good faith.
- to do everything reasonably possible to promote the success of Lindum Squash Club.
- not to do anything to damage the interests of Lindum Squash Club.
- to comply with all instructions from time to time issued by the Board of Lindum Sports Association and/or the Committee of Lindum Squash Club.
- to comply with all laws and regulations from time to time applying to Lindum Squash Club and/or its activities.
- to ensure that all necessary safety equipment is used. N.B. For all Junior Players Eye Protection as approved by Lindum Squash Club Committee is mandatory.
- to ensure that the Main Security Door is closed at all times.
- not to bring cycles or similar into the Lindum Squash Club premises.
- to ensure that at the end of each day all lights, fan and heaters are turned off and that the facilities and other assets of Lindum Squash are left safe and secure.
- to respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants in Lindum Squash (whether members, invitees, visitors, staff, stakeholders, suppliers or otherwise) regardless of age, gender, ability, disability, race, ethnic or national origin, cultural background, religious beliefs, marital status, sexual identity or any other protected characteristic.
- to be vigilant of discrimination, harassment, bullying and similar and report any behaviour which is inappropriate or could conceivably be held to be inappropriate to the Lindum Squash Club Chairman.
- to take excellent care of facilities, courts and equipment belonging to or under the control of Lindum Sports Association and/or Lindum Squash.
- to promptly report any problems with facilities, courts and equipment to the Chairman of Lindum Squash.
- to ensure that compliance with the rules of squash and/or racketball from time to time in force
- to understand and abide by the rules when participating in box leagues, teams, tournaments, Club nights and similar.



LINDUM SQUASH CLUB RULES

- to be an advocate for and set an example for decency and appropriate behaviour both when present at Lindum Squash Club facilities or representing Lindum Squash Club elsewhere.
- to always wear clean non marking footwear on court.
- to pay all fees including for membership, training and events promptly and without delay.
- not to allow non members to use Club facilities, play on or book courts in their name or in their absence.
- to obtain permission from the Lindum Squash Chairman and fill in the Guest Book before playing non members.
- to refrain from offensive, threatening and/or inappropriate words and/or behaviour.
- to recognise and respect the contribution by volunteers, coaches and officials.
- to support all efforts which are made to ensure that Lindum Squash Club is well managed.
- to support all efforts which are made to ensure that Lindum Squash Club provides a full range of squash and racketball opportunities.
- not to do anything which in the opinion of the board of Lindum Sports Association and/or Lindum Squash Club Committee is inappropriate or which brings or is likely to bring Lindum Squash Club into disrepute.
- Guests are only allowed to play up to three visits per year.
- Playing rights are as decided by the Committee in accordance with your membership category.

It is a condition of membership that members comply with the Rules as from time to time in force. Breaches of the Rules will be addressed by the Committee of Lindum Squash Club as per the document **Lindum Squash Club Resolution of Issues and Disciplinary**.
